

Zeta Sigma Psi Military Sorority Anti Hazing Policy

Per the hazing prevention.org website the definition of hazing is:

Any action taken or any situation created intentionally that causes embarrassment, harassment or ridicule, and risk emotional and/or physical harm to members of a group or team, whether new or not, regardless of the person's willingness to participate.

The Anti Hazing Policy of Zeta Sigma Psi Military Sorority, Inc. prohibits the hazing of any woman who aspire to attain membership, is a participant in the membership intake process, or who has been inducted as a member in this sorority. Hazing is defined as any activity or behavior towards another person that causes or threatens to cause emotional or physical injury or death, or which causes emotional and physical discomfort, embarrassment, harassment, or ridicule. Such prohibited activities and behaviors include, but are not limited to:

- 1) Yelling at, berating, or bullying an individual for any reason or purpose
- 2) Personal servitude
- 3) Any activities likely to cause fatigue.
- 4) Treasure or scavenger hunts
- 5) Engaging in stunts or pranks
- 6) Degrading or humiliating games and activities
- 7) Physical or emotional assaults
- 8) Activities that require complete or partial submerging in water
- 9) Any activity that may or can cause bleeding, bruising or lack of consciousness.

Any such activity is wrongful and violates the Sorority's policy regardless of whether any person or persons involved in the conduct believes that the participants in the activities are doing so by consent.

Zeta Sigma Psi has a zero tolerance for Hazing. All existing and prospective members have the right to be treated with dignity and respect. It is the responsibility of all members to report hazing incidents to the Master at Arms immediately.
